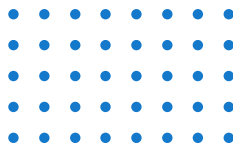

It means that each child has the same opportunity and that they are cared for and supported equally and so their needs are met.

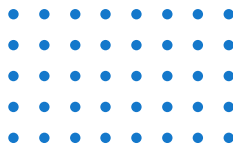
Which book, TV show or film do you recommend to everyone?
