Which book, TV show or film do you recommend to everyone?

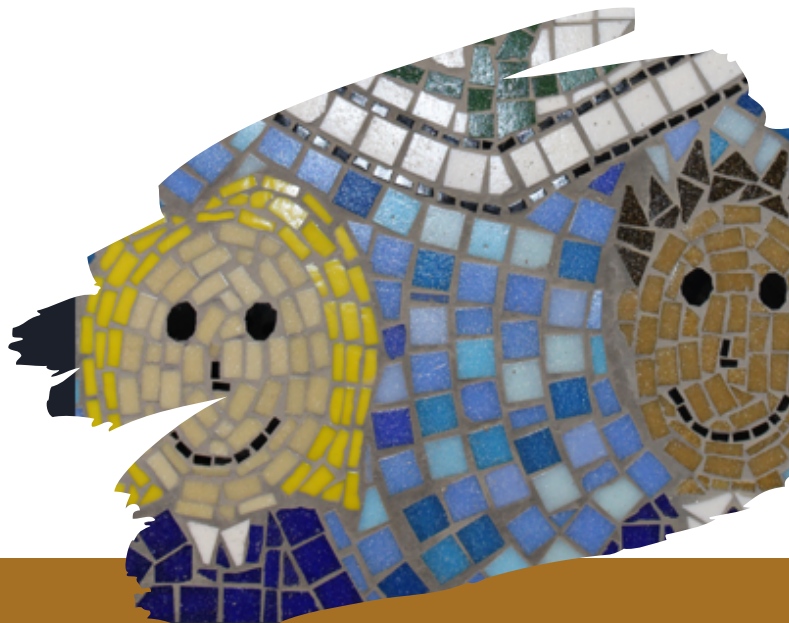

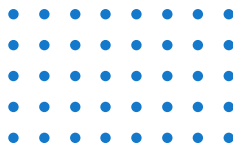
What's one thing on your bucket list you still hope to tick off?
