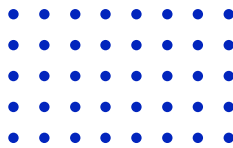

The Housemaid book is one of my favourites and it has recently been adapted into a film. I love a gripping story with a fantastic twist!

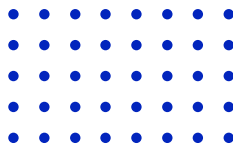
What do you think makes your school a unique place to work or learn?
