Do you have a favourite place you love to visit again and again?

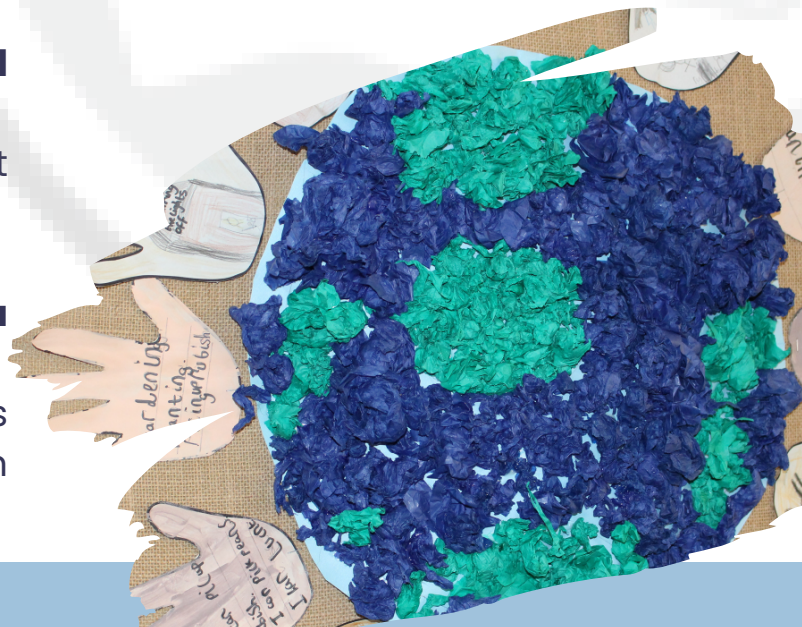
The Lake District for lots of walking up mountains.
